Board provided to some of the residents who are running for elected office copies of the Transfer Station Budget and the General Expense Budget. The thought behind the distribution is to provide these folks the ability to be up to speed when elected with regard to the Municipal Budget review.

Transfer Station Budget: Manager and Supervisor answered questions of the Selectmen and provided to them a change in the Budget Request. The request is \$476,617 which is \$18,012 less than the previous year's appropriation.

Board also reviewed the General Expense Budget which has a request of \$181,920 which is \$1,535 less than the previous year's appropriation.

The Board also opened the meeting up to the public for general questions to the Board members and the Town Manager.

Resident Jodie Wright commented upon her Land Use Violation from the Town on her Rooming House that has been resolved. Question was also raised on Legal Fees.

Resident Andrea Ouimet asked about the Transfer Station Attendant.

Resident Oscar Stone asked questions on snow plowing, snow removal, audit services and comments upon the Affordable Housing Project and the use of excess lands.

Residents Jodie Wright & Dave Rodrigue asked the Town Manager further questions on the Land Use Violation issued on their property and the subsequent documents they provided to the Town to satisfy the violation notice.
