

Prime Tanning Brownfields Program

This map depicts the status of the Town of Berwick's current Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Brownfields Program for the redevelopment of the former Prime Tanning Site.

The Town of Berwick acquired the site from Fund of Jupiter in 2014 in order to apply for Brownfields Cleanup Grants. In 2015 the Town was awarded a total of \$600,000 from the EPA to address contamination on lots 146-4, 146-5, and 146-6. The Town currently has a pending application to acquire \$600,000 more in federal funding in order to address environmental contamination on the rest of the site as well as the parking lot at the corner of Wilson and Sullivan Street.

Demolition is expected to begin on current award sites in late Spring or early Summer.
