

PUBLIC NOTICE

Earlier this year, a section of Hubbard Road experienced a slope failure near the so-called “S-Curve” along the river. As a result, Maine Department of Transportation (MDOT) has temporarily closed the road to one lane of traffic via alternating traffic signals. A plan to address this issue in a more permanent sense is in the design stages at this time. MDOT intends to shift the road away from the river, with construction lasting 3 months and also a likely detour of traffic during construction. It is not clear whether the detour would last the duration of construction or for some lesser period of time. It is also not clear where exactly the detour will take place. A staff meeting with MDOT, public works employees, public safety departments, ambulance service providers, and the local School District is scheduled for October 15th for the purpose of learning more and providing feedback to MDOT.
